- 3. We never offer anything of value—a meal, a trip to a training meeting, a round of golf, cash—to encourage new or recognize past sales volume.
- 4. The following are some examples of bribery. All of these activities are **prohibited**:
 - Pay cash to reward or thank a healthcare professional or government official for placing an order or using our products (pay per procedure).
 - Sponsor a healthcare professional or government official to a product training meeting or medical conference as a reward for current or future product orders.
 - o Pay expenses for the spouse of a healthcare professional or government official who is attending a product training meeting or a medical conference.
 - o Support illegal payments with fake consulting contracts or other false transactions.
 - Hire the friend or relative of a healthcare professional or government official to encourage or reward the purchase of products.
 - Provide any other form of personal benefit to a healthcare professional or government official to encourage or reward the purchase of products.
